The husband/wife team, along with the crew of "George", set upon the task of completely renovating 3 bedrooms, a bathroom, a hallway and more. The team worked tirelessly to secure donations from local tile, wood, furniture and decor vendors, with their company donating all of the labor and additional supplies that were needed.
